



How to Care for Your Shutters:

Recommended Cleaning Methods

Dusting: Regular dusting will help maintain a "like-new" appearance

Vacuuming: Using a brush attachment regular vacuuming will provide deeper cleaning Compressed Air: As long as the air is not heated (Hair dryer) compressed air can be used to

blow off any dust

Spot Cleaning: Shutters can be cleaned with a soft cloth or sponge with mild soap and water.

Do not use ammonia based products

Tension System


Over a period of time, it is possible that the louvers can loosen. Mirasol® Shutters have a tension screw installed into the side of each panel. Using a Phillips head screwdriver, the screw can be slightly tightened to increase the resistance level.

Louver Replacement

To replace a damaged louver, the following tools are required: Pliers, sharp putty knife (thin), replacement louver and kit (louver staple, regular louver pin and replacement pin)

Directions:

- 1. Using pliers, remove the staple from the damaged louver
- 2. Insert the putty knife between the louver and shoulder of the pin and strike the knife to shear off the pin. (see fig. A)
- **3.** Remove the broken or damaged louver and the broken pin from the louver and the stile
- 4. Insert the spring pin into the stile. Depress the pin into the stile and slide the louver over the pin until it pops in. (see fig. B)
- 5. Re-attach the staple
